### ***CAMP Scholars Program:***

The CAMP Scholars program supports UCSB undergraduates from under-represented groups in science, technology, engineering and mathematics to successfully graduate and further their education beyond the baccalaureate.

### ***Scholar Awards:***

Scholars are eligible to apply for the following support:

- CAMP Professional Development Series
- Science Textbook Scholarship
- GRE Preparation and Exam scholarship
- Graduate School Application award
- Graduate School Visit Travel award
- Travel to Conferences

In addition, Scholars receive information about research internship opportunities and are invited to professional development workshops, student study sessions, and seminars sponsored by the Materials Research Laboratory.

### ***Student Eligibility:***

This program is open to any science, engineering, or mathematics undergraduate student who meets the following requirements:

- Enrolled UCSB undergraduate student
- US citizen or permanent resident
- In good academic standing
- Member of an under-represented group: blacks/african americans, native americans/alaskans, pacific islanders, latinos and latinas

2. **Unofficial Transcripts**
3. **Statement of Interest:** Please submit a one-page written statement explaining why you are interested in participating in the program, your long-term goals, and how the program will assist you in accomplishing your goals.
